Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP) is updating its internal data systems in preparation for the AMD Chapter 9 Reporting coming into effect in January 2019.

As per AMD Chapter 9 clause RC3-A Ambient data must be electronically submitted to Alberta's Ambient Air Quality Data Warehouse. If you have an approval condition requirement to monitor and report ambient air please contact air.reporting@gov.ab.ca to receive your unique Ambient Station IDs.

It is very important to keep informed on these changes as they are time sensitive.
