This email acknowledges the receipt of your air monitoring report or notification to Alberta Environment and Parks (AEP).

With the Air Monitoring Directive Chapter 9 coming into effect January 1, 2019, air reporting will be submitted via ETS (Electronic Transfer System). Industrial operations will be required to submit air data and reports to ETS beginning January 1, 2019.

All companies need to have an account set up in ETS in order to complete the submissions. If you have any questions on ETS account setup, or who your company ETS administrator is please contact ETSAccountSetup@gov.ab.ca for assistance.

All regulatory facilities that have an approval condition requirement to monitor and report ambient air need to contact air.reporting@gov.ab.ca to receive their unique Ambient Station Identifiers for all ambient stations (continuous, intermittent, passive, dustfall).

It is very important to keep informed on these changes as they are time sensitive.

To receive the most up to date information on the reporting changes, you need to sign up to the AMD mailing list via <http://aep.alberta.ca/air/legislation-and-policy/air-monitoring-directive/default.aspx> also visit <http://aep.alberta.ca/air/legislation-and-policy/air-monitoring-directive/amd-toolbox.aspx> for Ambient XML schema and Reporting forms.
