Field Operations Assistant (Contract)

LICA is seeking a qualified contractor for a Field Operations Assistant (FOA) role supporting its air quality and deposition monitoring programs in the Lakeland region. This hands-on field role includes precipitation sampling, passive and integrated monitoring systems, soil sampling, and other support at LICA monitoring sites. It is best suited to someone who is comfortable working outdoors in varied conditions and can carry out field tasks with care, consistency, and attention to detail. The hourly contract is expected to begin in early May 2026, with some flexibility based on candidate availability, and will involve approximately 20–50 hours per month, including recurring weekly field responsibilities. Mileage and approved expenses will be reimbursed, and compensation will be based on experience, technical competency, and relevant certifications.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Diploma or degree in Environmental Technology, Natural Resources, or a related field
- Experience in environmental field sampling or monitoring programs
- Strong organizational, communication, and documentation skills
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively
- Ability to work outdoors in varying weather conditions and safely lift up to 40 pounds
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License and access to a reliable, field-suitable vehicle

- Familiarity with quality assurance/quality control (QA/QC) procedures, chain-of-custody documentation, and handling of environmental samples
- Experience working in or supporting regulatory or compliance-based monitoring programs
- Relevant safety certifications, such as H2S Alive, Standard or Intermediate First Aid, WHMIS, Fall Protection, Oilfield Driver Awareness, Wildlife Awareness, Chainsaw Safety, and OHV/ATV Operator Safety Training, as well as eligibility to obtain access authorization for the Cold Lake Air Weapons Range (CLAWR).
